Global Finance Names the World's 50 Safest Commercial Banks 2024

NEW YORK, October 7, 2024 — Global Finance has named the World's 50 Safest Commercial Banks for 2024 in an exclusive survey to be published in the November print and digital editions, as well as online at GFMag.com. For commercial banks to qualify for this ranking, they must not be majority owned by government or regional authorities.

Royal Bank of Canada maintains its ranking as the World's Safest Commercial Bank for the third straight year, and Canadian banks take five of the top 15 positions and seven overall. Singapore lands three banks in the top five, and the United States is represented by nine banks, the most of any country.

In addition to the World's 50 Safest Commercial Banks, the full report also includes the following: World's 50 Safest Banks; Safest Banks by Country, Territory and District; 50 Safest Banks in Emerging Markets; Safest Islamic Financial Institutions in the GCC and Safest Banks by Region (Africa, Asia, Australasia, Central & Eastern Europe, Latin America, the Middle East, North America, and Western Europe).

Global Finance's annual rankings of the World's Safest Banks have been the recognized and trusted standard of financial counterparty safety for more than three decades. Winners were selected through an evaluation of long-term foreign currency ratings—from Fitch, Moody's, and Standard & Poor's—of the 500 largest banks worldwide.

"Amid ongoing economic volatility and increasing scrutiny of digital currencies, the resilience and soundness of banks continue to be the bedrock of global commerce in 2024," said Joseph Giarraputo, founder and editorial director of Global Finance.
